

4-H Camp Leslie 2010 CIT Program Information

Overview: Camp Leslie's Counselor In Training (CIT) Program is designed for those campers who turn 14 by July 1, 2010, and who are interested in becoming better leaders. This program covers an intense curriculum that includes such topics as leadership, conflict resolution, child development and group dynamics that leads to the making of a successful Camp Leslie Counselor. CIT's attend for two week sessions (Weeks 1 and 2 (new CITs only), 3 and 4, or 5 and 6), and will be evaluated by the Camp Staff at the end of their session. Successful completion of the program and positive evaluations could lead to the participant being invited back the following season as an Intern. Because of the small number of spaces available and the highly competitive nature of this program, all potential applicants must complete the following application in order to determine suitability for the program.

Back For 2010: Since this program continues to be so popular, we will continue with the changes that were implemented in 2009. In order to allow us to accommodate the maximum number of applicants, all CITs will initially be limited to only one 2 week session. You may select a second two week session if you wish, but acceptance into that second session will not take place until our Open House (May 16). **Please mail the completed CIT application and a standard registration form from our brochure with a \$100 per week deposit check to: 4-H Camp Leslie Registrar, P.O. Box 1858, Wakefield, MA 01880. DO NOT SEND THE APPLICATION TO THE CAMP'S GEORGETOWN ADDRESS!** Applications will be reviewed and accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis, and all accepted participants will be notified within 14 days of the application being received.
